## **CEMETERY REGULATIONS**

1. Stones and memorials/plaques should be of a style, nature and colour in keeping with current memorials, tributes and traditions of the village cemetery.
2. No kerb stones will be allowed around grave areas.
3. The wording/photographs on headstones/memorials etc. should have prior approval of the Parish Council.
4. Headstones, tablets etc. should not exceed 42 inches in height, 30 inches in width and 6 inches in depth. Plinth stones should be of a size commensurate with the above. Gravestones, headstones, memorials or statues should not extend beyond the limits of the grave plot.
5. Grave areas should be of a low maintenance type.
6. Permanent memorials must be of a stone/ stone like material. Wooden memorials will only be allowed as a temporary measure.
7. Caskets should not be of larger dimensions than the normal English style coffin. This is because of the constraints of space within the cemetery.
8. Trees and shrubs should only be planted with the prior permission of the Parish Council.
9. All applications for erection of headstones/memorial stones will be considered by the Parish Council against the current cemetery regulations.
